



The Greatest Story and Me – Day 1

Use these discussion starters and activities to help affirm with your kid(s) the part of *The Greatest Story* that we discussed today.

1. Read Genesis 1 and 2 with your kid(s). Ask them what their favorite part of the story is? See if they can identify what God created on each day.
2. Go outside (or to a window) and look around. Ask them to spot something awesome they see that God made and ask them to describe it and why it's so awesome. (Maybe do this multiple times) Remind them that God is so awesome that He made everything, something we couldn't do!
3. Remind them that God made us, that He is in charge and has a right to tell us how to live. (And by the way, how He wants us to live is BEST for us!) Ask them why it's hard to let God be in charge of our lives and do what He tells us to do all the time.
4. Remind them that God created us and we are made in God's image, and that makes us more special than anything else that God created. Ask them about someone in their life that they find hard to love or be nice to. Discuss with them how that person is made in God's image just like they are. Ask them how that can help them love, respect, and value that person more.
5. Remind them that God is holy and wants us to be holy too. Ask them to identify at least one way that they sin and are not holy. Read John 3:16 with them and remind them that Jesus came to die for our sin that we could be forgiven of our sin.
6. Print a copy of the memory verse game (link provided on the VBS page on the website) or use the one included in your craft packet. Play one of the games together.
