



## **The Greatest Story and Me – Day 2**

Use these discussion starters and activities to help affirm with your kid(s) the part of *The Greatest Story* that we discussed today.

1. Read Genesis 3 with your kid(s). Ask them what really sticks out to them about that story.
2. Tell your kid(s) a sin or some sins that you have struggled with or are struggling with. Write them on a piece of paper or draw a picture representing them.
3. Ask them to identify some things that they do wrong (sin) or have done wrong that God tells them not to do. Get them to write them on a piece of paper (or you do that for them) or get them to draw a picture representing that sin. Read John 3:16 together. Tell them that if they turn from their sin and believe that Jesus died for their sin so they could be forgiven and give their lives to Him, then their sin can be forgiven. To illustrate that, crumple up both of your papers and throw them away.
4. If your kids are old enough, invite them to write a letter to God admitting some things they have done wrong and asking Him to forgive them.
5. Get your kids to draw a picture that shows how much God loves them.
6. Do one of the Memory Verse Games in the craft packet.
