



The Greatest Story and Me – Day 3

Use these discussion starters and activities to help affirm with your kid(s) the part of *The Greatest Story* that we discussed today.

1. Read John 11.1-44 with your kids. Ask them what their favorite part of the story is.
2. Get them to draw a picture of the story.
3. Ask them why we can believe that Jesus is the Son of God. Make a list of different ways that Jesus is greater than us.
4. Ask them what Jesus raising Lazarus from the dead shows us about Him and why that should bring us comfort.
5. Ask them one thing that they may be scared or worried about right now, or something that is causing them pain or struggle. Remind them that this story shows us that Jesus cares for us. Remind them that He is powerful enough to help them during that time. Pray with them, thanking God that He cares and asking Him to help in whatever is causing them fear, worry, or pain. Tell them they can pray to God on their own like this.
6. If Jesus truly is the Son of God (and He is!) and He says He is the only way to God forever (John 14:6), then we can trust what He says because He is God! Any other religious thought or belief is not the way to eternal life. Only Jesus. Help your kids understand this.
7. Do one of the Memory Verse Games in the craft packet.
