



Reviewing The Greatest Story – Day 3

Ask these questions of your kid(s) to help them remember the part of the *The Greatest Story* that we learned today.

1. From what Scripture was today's Bible story? (*John 11*)
2. Who were Jesus' three friends from the story? (*Martha, Mary, and Lazarus*)
Where did they live? (*Bethany*)
3. What happened to Lazarus? (*He died*) When Jesus got back to Bethany, how long had Lazarus been dead? (*4 days*)
4. How did Jesus respond when He saw Mary weeping? (*He was deeply moved*) After He asked where they put Lazarus after He died, what did Jesus do? (*He wept*) Did Jesus care for them? (*Yes*)
5. When Jesus went to Lazarus' tomb, what did He say? (*"Lazarus, come out!"*) And then what happened? (*Lazarus came back alive and walked out with graveclothes on him*)
6. What did Jesus raising Lazarus from the dead do for some of the people who saw it happen? (*They believed in Jesus*)
7. What are some other miracles Jesus did? (*healed sick people, calmed a storm, multiplied two fish and five loaves of bread to feed 5,000 people, made the blind see, made paralyzed people walk, etc.*) What do all these miraculous works that Jesus did prove about Him? (*He is the Son of God, He is God in the flesh, He is all-powerful*)
8. What big event happened that proved that Jesus is the Son of God? (*He Himself rose from the dead*)
9. Why did John write his book? (*Hint: John 20:30-31*)
10. Since Jesus is the Son of God, can we trust what He says about the only way to have our sins forgiven? (*Yes*) What does He say that God did so that our sins could be forgiven? (*Hint: John 3:16*) What does John 3:16 mean? (*God sent His only Son, Jesus, to die on the cross to pay the punishment for our sin, to raise from the dead to show our sin is fully paid for and that He is truly the Son of God, so that we could turn from our sin and put our faith in Him, His death, and His resurrection as the only way our sin could be forgiven so we could have eternal life*)
