



## **The Greatest Story and Me – Day 4**

Use these discussion starters and activities to help affirm with your kid(s) the part of *The Greatest Story* that we discussed today.

1. Read Matthew 27-28 with your children. Ask them what really sticks out to them about that story.
2. Encourage your kids to draw a picture of some of the different scenes of today's story (crucifixion, resurrection, His appearances after the resurrection) and to write their memory verse on the picture somewhere.
3. To help them understand that Jesus died to be punished for THEIR sin, encourage them to draw a cross and to write some of the sins that they struggle with on the cross.
4. Encourage your kid(s) to write a thank you letter to Jesus for dying for their sin.
5. Encourage your kids to write a poem:
  - a. About the crucifixion
  - b. Praising Jesus for His resurrection
  - c. Or both!
6. Find a black shirt and a white shirt and re-enact the illustration that Pastor Ken used at the end of today's Bible story.
7. Do one of the Memory Verse Games in the craft packet or download the activity from the VBS DAY FOUR page.
8. Some supporting verses for today's story and its application: Romans 1:4, Romans 4:25 – 5:1, Romans 5:8, Romans 6:23, 1 Corinthians 15:3-4, 2 Corinthians 5:21, 1 Peter 2:24, 1 John 4:10.
