



Reviewing The Greatest Story – Day 4

Ask these questions of your kid(s) to help them remember the part of the *The Greatest Story* that we learned today.

1. From what Scripture did today's story come from? (*Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John; specifically Matthew chapters 27 and 28*)
2. What did the religious leaders want to do to Jesus? (*kill him*)
3. Which of Jesus' friends betrayed Him and for how much money? (*Judas, 30 pieces of silver*) How many times did Peter deny Jesus? (*three*)
4. What prisoner did the crowd choose to be released instead of Jesus? (*Barabbas*) What was one of his crimes? (*murder*)
5. What types of suffering did Jesus go through? (*being spit on, beaten, mocked, crown of thorns, crucified*) What was Jesus nailed to? (*a cross*)
6. While Jesus was on the cross, during what hours was it dark? (*noon - 3pm*) What else happened when Jesus died? (*earthquake*) On what day did Jesus die? (*Friday*)
7. What did the Roman soldier say when Jesus died? (*"Truly this was the Son of God"*)
8. What happened on the third day after Jesus died? (*He rose from the dead!*) On what day was this? (*Sunday*)
9. What does His resurrection prove about Him? (*He is the Son of God, Romans 1:4*)
10. What are some of the people that Jesus appeared to after He rose? (*the women, His other disciples, more than 500 of His followers...at one time!*)
11. What did one of His followers, named Thomas, say when He saw Jesus' scars after He was risen? (*"My Lord and my God!"*)
12. Why did Jesus allow all this to happen to Him? (*to pay the penalty for our sins so we could be forgiven and have eternal life if we will believe in Him*)
13. What does John 3:16 mean? (*God sent His only Son, Jesus, to die on the cross to pay the punishment for our sin, to raise from the dead to show our sin is fully paid for and that He is truly the Son of God, so that we could turn from our sin and put our faith in Him, His death, and His resurrection as the only way our sin could be forgiven so we could have eternal life*)
