



Reviewing The Greatest Story – Day 5

Ask these questions of your kid(s) to help them remember the part of the *The Greatest Story* that we learned today.

1. From what Scripture did today's story come from? (*Acts 16*)
2. Who were the two men who were put in prison? (*Paul and Silas*)
3. Why was it so amazing that Paul was a follower of Jesus? (*because he once hated Christians*)
4. What did Paul and Silas do, instead of whining, when they were fastened in the stocks in the prison? (*praying and singing hymns to God*)
5. What happened after that? (*God sent an earthquake, all the prisoners' bonds were broken and all the prison doors were opened*)
6. How did the jailer respond? And how did Paul respond to him? (*Parent: Judge for yourselves how you will communicate Acts 16:27-28 to your kids while not changing the truth of the passage*)
7. What did the jailer ask Paul and Silas? (*"Sirs, what must I do to be saved?"*)
8. How did they respond? (*"Believe in the Lord Jesus, and you will be saved, you and your household."*)
9. What happened after that? (*Paul and Silas spoke the Word to the jailer and all in his house, the jailer washed their wounds, the jailer and his family were saved and baptized, the jailer fed Paul and Silas, he and his entire household rejoiced that they believed in God*)
10. How does this story relate to our memory verse, John 3:16? (*The jailer and his family believed in Jesus, were saved, and now had eternal life!*)
11. What does John 3:16 mean? (*God sent His only Son, Jesus, to die on the cross to pay the punishment for our sin, to raise from the dead to show our sin is fully paid for and that He is truly the Son of God, so that we could turn from our sin and put our faith in Him, His death, and His resurrection as the only way our sin could be forgiven so we could have eternal life*)
