MEMORY VERSE GAME #1

1. Cut out on the dotted lines.
2. Place the verse on the table/floor in the correct order.
3. Read the verse together a few times.
4. Turn some of the cards over facedown and see if they can start to say the whole verse including the words/phrases they can't see.
5. Eventually turn all the pieces facedown to see if they can say the whole verse.

MEMORY VERSE GAME #2

1. Cut out on the dotted lines.
2. Place the verse on the table/floor in the correct order and read the verse together a few times.
3. Mix the cards up and put them in a stack.
4. Time each kid(s) to see how long it takes them to put them in the correct order and say the verse. If you have multiple kids, make it a fun competition to see which kid can do it faster. If you have only one kid participating, give them a time to beat. If they beat it, lower the time limit to see if they can beat it. Award prizes accordingly if you see fit.
5. Alternate competition: Use multiple stacks for kid(s) to compete at the same time against you or one another at the same time.

MEMORY VERSE GAME #3

1. Cut out on the dotted lines.
2. Place the verse on the table/floor in the correct order and read the verse together a few times.
3. Hide each card in different places in the room somewhere (or outside).
4. Time each kid(s) to see how long it takes for them to find them and put them in the correct order and say the verse. If you have multiple kids, make it a fun competition to see which kid can do it faster. If you have only one kid participating, give them a time to beat. If they beat it, lower the time limit to see if they can beat it. Award prizes accordingly if you see fit.

MEMORY VERSE GAME #4

1. Cut out on the dotted lines.
2. Place the verse on the table/floor in the correct order and read the verse together a few times. Collect all the cards.
3. Ask questions from today's Bible story. If they get the answer correct, give them a card. Once they answer enough questions to receive all the cards, get them to arrange the cards in the correct order. Say the verse together.
4. If you have multiple kids, use multiple decks of verse cards and make this a competition to see who can answer the question first and receive all the verse cards from their deck verse first.
5. Award prizes accordingly as you see fit.
